

Web site to find elected officials, Federal and State

www.congress.org/congressorg/home

- Enter zip code in upper right side of screen
- If zip code has more than one district, enter the +4 code or enter your address
- The next page will give the Congressional and Legislative district numbers, the names and parties of the elected officials for that district.
- Selecting on any of the names (in blue) will show that official's bio, contact information, committee assignments, and recent letters sent to that official

Web site to Arizona State Legislature

- From this site state elected officials and contact information can be found
 - If the name or the district number is known
 - Select "click to see members" (located center of screen) this will give the name, email, and telephone number for each member
 - If the name or district are not know
 - Select "How do find my legislators" (left side of screen)
 - Select "click here" from item number 2
 - Enter address and zip code (upper right side of screen)
 - Results will be on left side, center of screen and will give an opportunity to select a list for Congress or Legislative officials
- This site has opportunities to find out a lot of information about the legislative session, including bills, agendas, etc. (see list on left side of screen)
- The center of the screen gives a path to "Request to Speak" or "ALIS Tracking"

Suggestion, go to this site and look around, become familiar with the site. The site is a good place to find out what is happening to a bill you are watching.
