With permission from the person, please let us know so that we may respond with pastoral care and visitation. Also, please get permission regarding what can be shared for reasons of corporate prayer during our celebration/worship services. Without explicit permission we will pray but not share. Again, *"We will need to know if the medical information is to be kept confidential, or if it can be included in the Nuggets and/or mentioned during Sunday Services. Please note: the Nuggets are posted on the Shadow Rock website and therefore, information is accessible through the internet.*
