 All are welcome to join us after worship for Coffee Chat in Smith Hall. Thank you to members of the choir for being our hosts this morning.

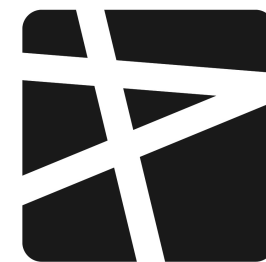
Faith Formation For All Ages
